

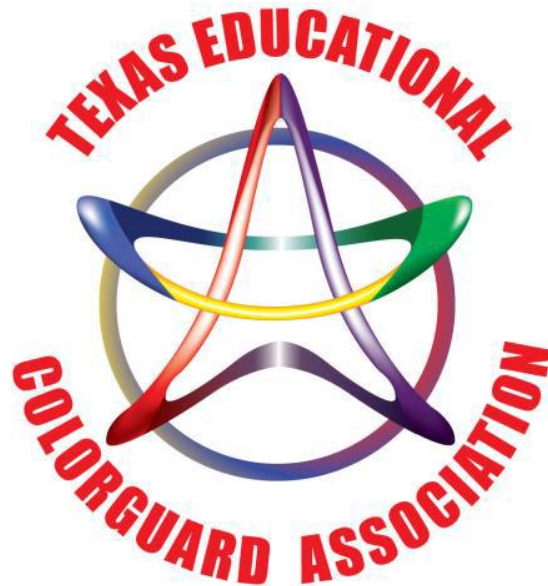

I. Location, Directions

The PHS Lobo Winterguard Invitational will be held at Palmview High School which is located at 3901 N. La Homa Rd., Mission, TX 78573.

From San Antonio or points north:

Take US-281 South to McAllen, TX.

Take exit US-83 W/McAllen and merge onto I-2/US-83 W.
Continue on US-83 West until you get to Mission TX.

You will then take the La Homa Rd. / Bensten Palm Dr. Exit
(TX-364 N/W Expy 83 Frontage Rd.)

Turn right on La Homa Rd. and Drive 3 miles north.
School will be on your left hand side.

From Laredo:

Take US-83 South to Mission, TX

Exit W Expy 83 / E Frontage Rd.

Turn left onto La Homa Rd.

Go north 3 miles, school will be on your left hand side.

Check In

The check-in table will be located at the entrance of the Cafeteria on the South Side. Refer to map for info.

Performers, Crew, and Directors will receive a stamp to distinguish participants from spectators. Performing members and crew members will need to check in at the check-in table when they arrive on campus. **Admission will be given to all performing members, 3 directors plus 10 student crew members. Any extra members will be asked to pay the regular admission price.**

Equipment Inspection

At this point all equipment will be inspected. All props, performance shoes, and equipment must be padded and taped according to the T.E.C.A. and WGI rulebook specifications. Please refer to the 2015 WGI Percussion Adjudication Manual and Rule Book. Maps of the school and performance times will be available in the director's packet at the check-in table.

Glitter No glitter of any kind will be carried out onto the floor. This includes, but is not limited to, glitter in the performers hands, small containers, glitter in flags or glitter in any device that is used to toss, throw, or project glitter. There will be no exceptions. **This goes for performances as well as retreat!**

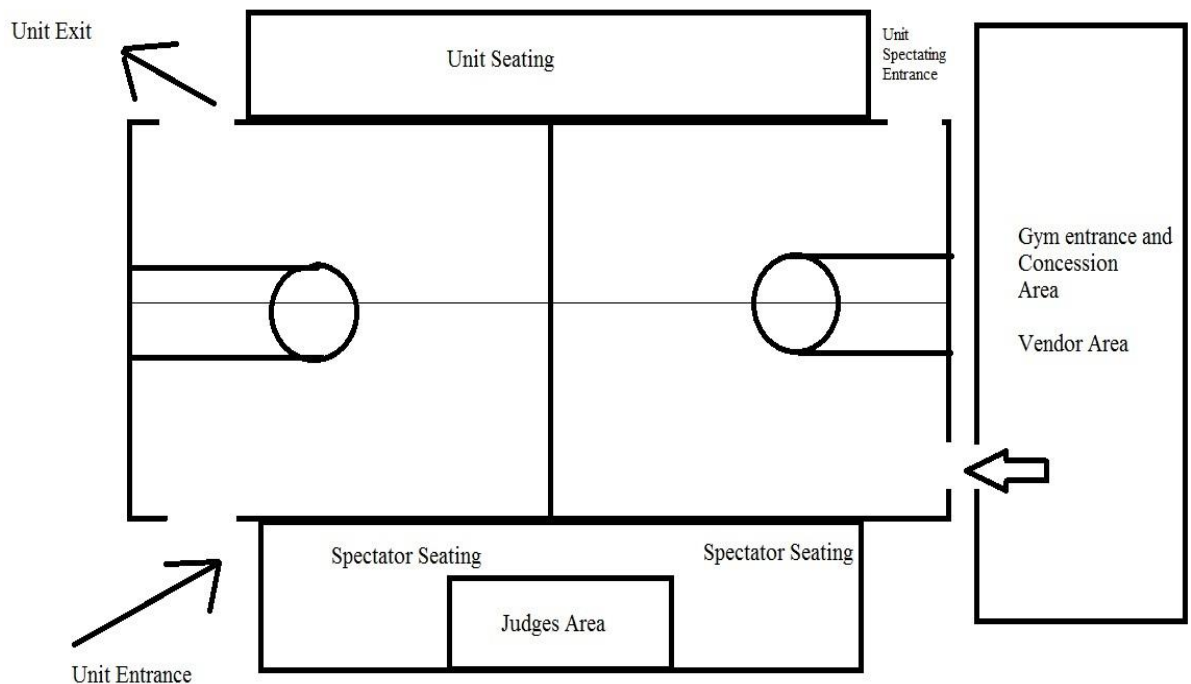
Official Photo

Lifetouch National School Studios will be taking group and candid photos throughout the day. Group photos will be taken prior to your performance time. Each unit will be led to the camera area for the photo. From the photo, the unit will proceed to the Performance Gym. You will be placed in holding until your official set up and performance time starts. Wait for the cue from the T.E.C.A. timing person.

After your performance, units will exit through the doors on the back left side (from the performers' perspective) back outside.

WE WILL BE UTILIZING A HORIZONTAL CENTER LINE FLOW FOR THE PERFORMANCE AREA.

From audience perspective, you will enter from the Left and exit to the Left.

Video Taping/Recording

To comply with Federal Copyright Laws, each unit may have only one person recording their performance. Recording will only be allowed within a designated area and will only be allowed for your unit's performance. Recording will not be allowed of any other unit or performance. T.E.C.A. will provide a Director's DVD of their respective unit in Championship performance which will be mailed to the directors' address. Please refrain from posting video of your performance on YouTube, Facebook, etc...

Post Performance

The exit will lead you OUTSIDE. After you exit the performance area, staff members will need to make sure that all of their equipment is put away, then return to the gym.

THERE WILL BE NO CRITIQUE AT CHAMPIONSHIPS.

Students will need to start their "line up" outside the entrance doors after the last classification of the last block before Retreat.

This will be a FULL RETREAT – all performers will participate. Instructors will need to help with the lineup of their students.
