- Props & equipment storage
- Adequate parking, restrooms/dressing rooms
- First Aid and Security

- Tables in the gym for administrators, judges and sound
- Runners and student aides
- Judges' lounging area (Teachers' lounge, classroom or band hall) with meals
- Critique area
- Adequate parking,

- First Aid
- Security
