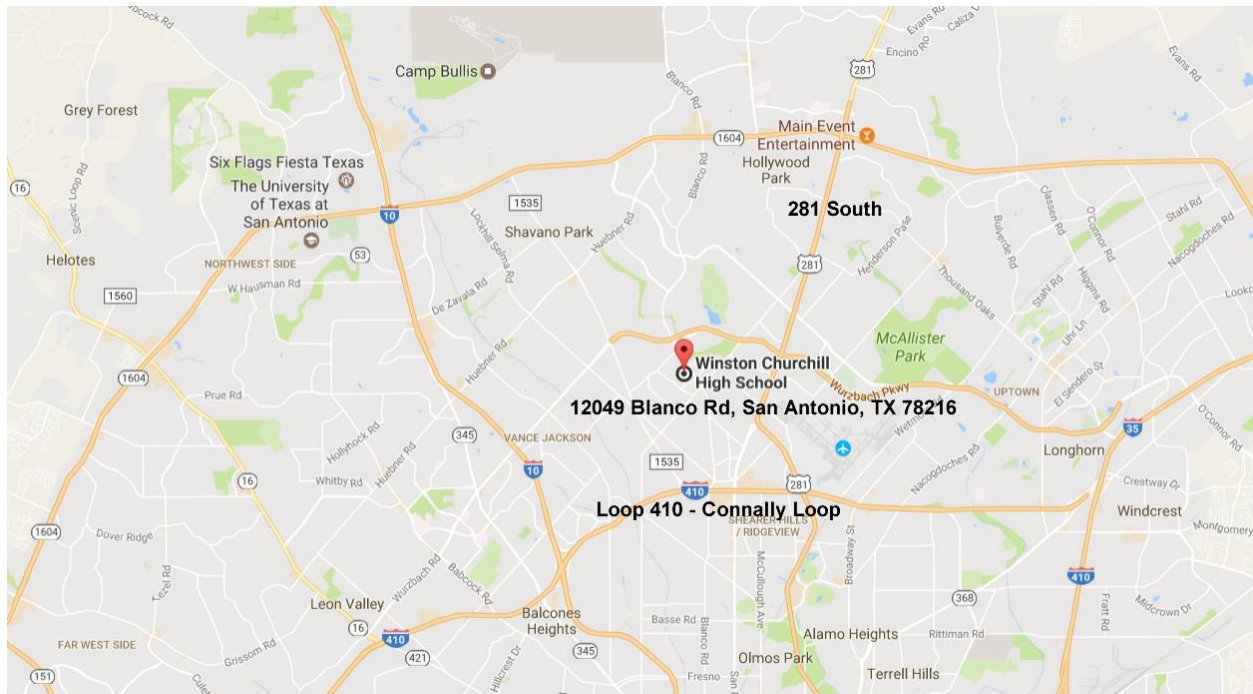

From 281 South:

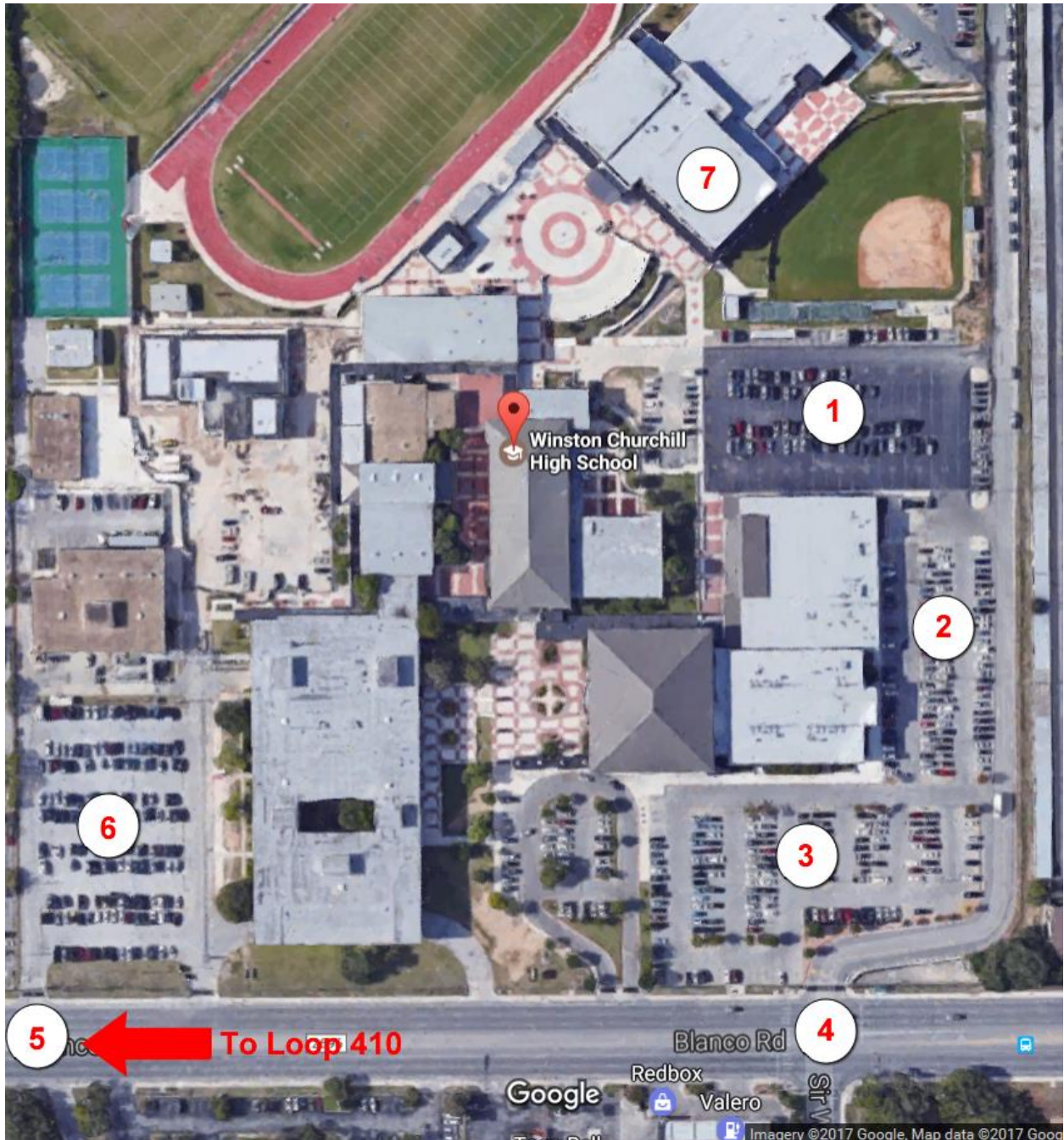
- Take the exit toward Wurzbach Pkwy/Nakoma Dr.
- Stay to your far-right lane on the access road.
- Turn right onto Wurzbach Pkwy.
- Head west on Wurzbach Pkwy.
- Take the ramp on the left onto Wurzbach Pkwy.
- Use the right 2 lanes to take the Blanco Rd exit.
- Turn left onto Blanco Rd.

From Loop 410 - Connally Loop:

- Take exit 20A toward Texas 537 Spur/Blanco Rd/San Pedro Ave/FM 2696
- Merge onto I- 410 Access Rd/NW Loop 410
- Keep left to stay on I- 410 Access Rd/NW Loop 410
- Turn right onto Blanco Rd
- Turn left at Sir Winston St

Parking:

All spectator parking will be in the front parking lot area of the school. There will be volunteers on hand and clearly posted signs to help you find your way to the performance gym.

Spectator Admission

Wrist bands will be sold at the entrance to the gymnasium. All spectators must have a wrist band to enter the competition.

Admission is \$10.00 for adults. \$5.00 Students. Children under 5 are free.
Cash and Credit Cards accepted.

Performing Members, Crew and Staff Admission

Performing members will need to report to the Check In table prior to warm up.

Admission bracelets will be provided for 3 directors, 2 bus drivers, and up to 10 student crew members.

Additional admission bracelets may be purchased at the Check In table for additional crew members at a cost of \$3 per student.

Unit Check In

The Check In table for all color guard and percussion groups will be located in the school cafeteria.

Percussion / Drum Line

Warm up for front ensemble and drum line will be in the ROTC parking lot. See item number 6 in the contest flow image on the next page for warm up location.

All percussion equipment trucks will park and unload in the lower front parking lot as illustrated in item number 6 of the parking lot image on the previous page.

Color Guard Area

Tables will be set up in the cafeteria for each group to store personal items.

Please only use one table per school or only the amount of space that you need so that we can accommodate all schools. You may be asked to consolidate space if necessary.

Props/Floors and larger equipment will be stored in the Prop Storage Area in the equipment warm up gym or by your trucks and trailers.

Students and staff will not spin, toss or maneuver any equipment at any time other than in designated warm up areas.

Contest Flow:

All contest rules and regulations from the TECA Constitution and Bi-Laws and the WGI Rule Book will be followed.

BODY WARM UP

According to the schedule, when it is time for your group to be “READY”, please report to the Ready table located in the cafeteria. You will be escorted by a monitor to each warm up area.

Body warm up will be in the Dance Hall across from the cafeteria. Students may stretch or do a body type of run through. No equipment will be allowed during this segment of the official warm up time.

EQUIPMENT WARM UP

After Body Warm Up, your group will be led to the warm up gym and will be placed in holding until your equipment warm up time starts.

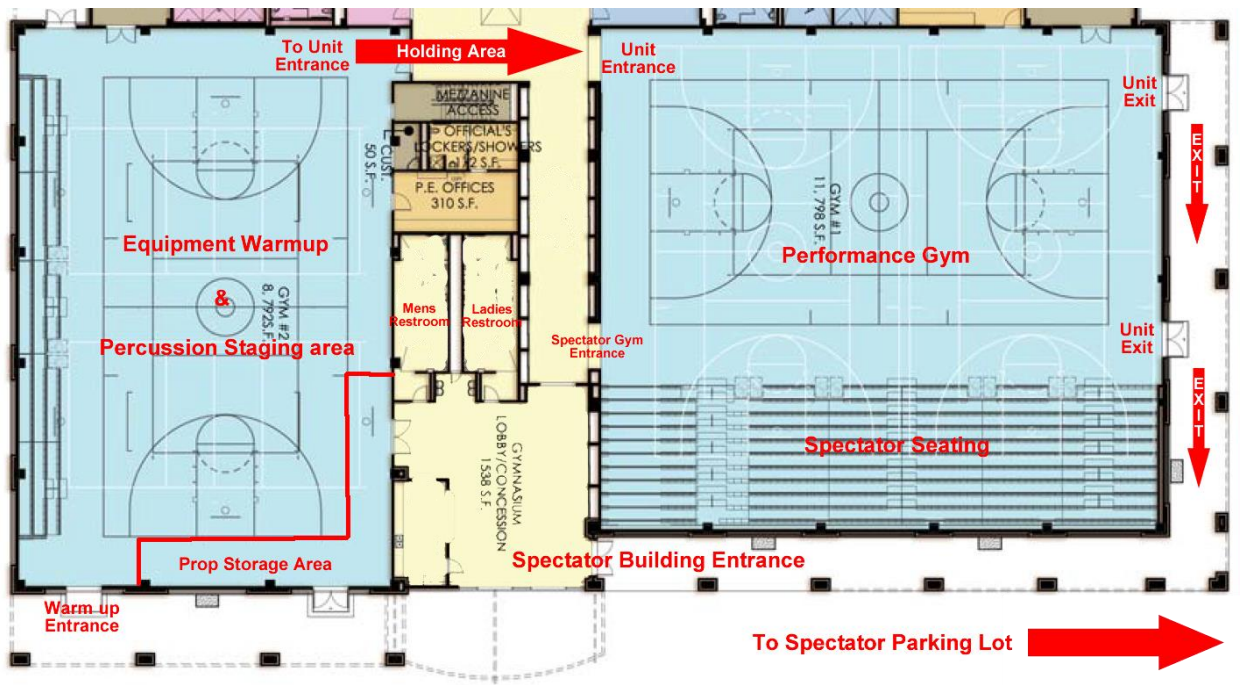
A sound system will be made available to you in both body and equipment warm up areas.

PERFORMANCE

After Equipment Warm Up, your group will be led to the performance area.

You will be placed in holding until your official set up and performance time begins.

Performing units will enter the performance area through the back left and exit through the back left or front right doors. (See Gym Flow Map below)



Post-Performance

After you exit the performance area, staff and members will need to make sure that all of their instruments and equipment are put away.
