

# **General Guidelines Guard and Percussion**


- 1. Check –In Table is located in front of the Practice Gym.
- 2. Tarps and Props will be staged inside the Band Hall.
- 3. Once your bus and trailer is unloaded, vehicles MUST be moved to designated parking areas. (See Map Below)
- 4. Holding areas are traffic areas only. Students and Staff are not allowed to maneuver equipment or play instruments inside any of the buildings.
- 5. Units should utilize available outdoor areas to warm up.
- 6. A HORIZONTAL Time Line will be utilized for this competition.
- 7. Captain's Only Retreat will follow the last scheduled performing group. All Captains should meet in the Gym Hallway.
- 8. A critique session hosted by the adjudicators and TECA will be available for those who are pre-registered.
- 9. Director's Critique will be held inside the Orchestra Room. Listening to your audio comments prior to entering critique is beneficial for both parties.
- 10. Audio comments and score sheets will be sent electronically through Competition Suite.
- 11. Directors, be sure all equipment and instruments are loaded in your trailers prior to departure.

# GUARD

- All Directors should have their Floor Access Pass. 10 additional floor crew admission wristbands will be given inside the Unit's packets. Additional wristbands may be purchased at the entrance of the performance area for \$5 per student.
- 2. Performers must show the Check-in Representative that their equipment is correctly padded and taped.
- 3. Equipment should be stored with team's personal belongings.
- 4. The Unit Holding Area is located in the Main Building.
- 5. No outside food or colored drinks are allowed in the Main Building.
- 6. Official Movement Warm-Up is located in the Dance Studio.
- 7. Official Equipment Warm-Up is located in the Practice Gym.
- 8. Official Performance is located in the Main Gym.
- 9. Unit's will fold tarp in the cement circle in the courtyard.



# PERCUSSION

- All Directors should have their Floor Access Pass. 10 additional floor crew admission wrist bands will be given inside the Unit's packets. Additional wristbands may be purchased at the entrance of the performance area for \$5 per student.
- 2. Performers must show the Check-In Representative that their equipment is correctly padded and taped.
- 3. It is vital to keep our facilities in good condition. We want to avoid scratches on the wood floors.
- 4. Units will be escorted to the designated holding area.
- 5. Units will not be allowed to play instruments outside of the performance area.
