
Harlan Percussion/Colorguard Showcase Information


The Culebra Rd entrance is only open going towards 1604

Contest Information

- All contest rules and regulations from the 2019-2020 TECA Constitution and By-Laws and the 2019-2020 WGI Rule Books will be followed.
- All Props, performance shoes and equipment must be padded and taped according to the TECA and WGI rule book specifications. Please refer to the 2019-2020 WGI Colorguard and Adjudication Manual and Rule Book for further information.

Check-In

- The check in table for guard participants will be located in Harlan High School inside by the bus loop.
- Performers will show the monitors that all equipment is properly padded and taped before they enter the gym for **Movement** in the equipment check area.
- Maps of the school and a schedule of performance times will be available at check-in.

Percussion/Guard Crew and Staff Admission

- Performing members will need to report to their table in the cafeteria prior to warm-up.
- Admission stamps will be provided for 30 performers, 2 bus drivers, and up to 10 student crew members.
- Additional admission stamps may be purchased at the check-in table for additional crew members at a cost of \$5 per student.

Percussion/Colorguard Area

- Tables will be set up in the cafeteria for each group to store personal items.
- Props/Floors and larger equipment will be stored in the Prop Storage Area outside of the Main Gym in the breezeway.

The cafeteria and hallways are traffic areas only. Students and staff will not spin, toss or maneuver any equipment at any time other than in designated warm-up areas.

• You may use the area **OUTSIDE** the check-in area for extra equipment warm-up

Official Warm-Up Time and Performance

Body Warm-Up

- When it is time for your group to be "READY", please report to the cafeteria
 You will be escorted by a monitor from there to each warm-up area.
- Body warm-up will be in the Dance Studio/Cheer Studio (D117). Students may stretch or do a body type of run through.
 - No equipment will be allowed during this segment of the official warm-up time
- A sound system will be made available to you in the body warm-up area.

Equipment Warm-Up

- After Body Warm-Up, your group will be led to the warm-up gym and will placed in the holding until your Equipment Warm-Up time starts
- Equipment Warm-Up will be in Gym 2 (D110)
- A sound system will be made available to you in the Equipment Warm-Up area.

Performance

- After Equipment Warm-Up, your group will be led to the performance area.
- You will be placed in holding until your official set up and performance time begins.
- Performance will be in the Main Gym (G111)

- Retreat will follow the last performing group
- Participants will be given the opportunity to attend critique session hosted by the judges and TECA

Spectator Admission

- Spectators will receive a stamp at the spectator entrance.
- ALL SPECTATORS MUST HAVE A STAMP TO ENTER THE COMPETITION
