**If traveling North on Hwy. 83:**

Turn right into Cielito Lindo Blvd.

**If traveling North on Loop 20:**

Take the U-Turn at Sierra Vista Blvd. and travel South and turn right once you reach Cielito Lindo Blvd.


**If traveling South on Loop 20:** Turn right into Cielito Lindo Blvd.

**A Gate:** Bus & Trailer Parking

**B Gate:** Prop/Equipment Drop Off

**C Gate:** Spectator Entrance/Exit

**Overflow Parking** will be in Lamar Bruni Vergara Middle School Parking Lot.



While at the contest, please follow all TECA Constitution rules, by-laws, and WGI rulebook.

## **PARKING**

Spectator parking will be at the Student Parking Lot; entrance is through the gate next to the Marching Pad on St. Luke St. All spectators will enter through the doors next to the Equipment Warm-up Gym.

Equipment trucks ONLY will enter the LBJ HS campus through the Main gate at the front of the school on Cielito Lindo Blvd. and unload there. Once props and floors are unloaded and taken through the designated entrance, equipment trucks will park in the Teacher parking lot on the side of the school next to Ejido St.

Buses will enter campus through the side of the school at the gate next to the Teacher parking lot on Ejido St. and unload for unit check-in at the Bus Loop next to the Cafeteria. Once students are unloaded, buses will exit the Bus Loop and park in the Teacher parking lot.

Overflow parking will be at Lamar Bruni Vergara Middle School and Veterans Memorial Elementary School, on St. Luke St. directly southeast of the LBJ HS campus.

## **CHECK-IN**

The check-in table will be located outside the Cafeteria at the patio area next to the Bus Loop. All performing members must check-in prior to warmup and ensure that all equipment is properly padded and taped. Outdoor areas for Percussion and Guard warm-up will be first come, first served.

## **ADMISSION**

Admission will be given to all performers, staff, and up to 10 student crew members. Admission for (Spectators) Students - \$10.00 (children under 5 free) Adults - \$15.00.

## **UNIT HOLDING AREA**

The Cafeteria will serve as the holding area for all units. Each unit will have a designated table, please use only the table(s) labeled for your school. Concessions will be available outside the Performance Gym. No outside food or drink is allowed.

Students and Staff may not spin, toss, or maneuver equipment inside any of the buildings at any time other than in designated areas. You may use the designated outside areas for extra warm-up.

## PERFORMANCE


Ready Time – When it is time for your group to be ready, a monitor will go to your table and escort you to Body Warm-up. Equipment and props will be double checked for appropriate taping for protection of the gym floors.

Body Warm-Up – From the Cafeteria, students will proceed with their monitor to Body Warm-up in the Band Hall. Students may stretch or do a run through of body mechanics. No equipment will be utilized during this portion of the warm-up time. A sound system will be available.

Equipment Warm-Up – From Body Warm-Up, students will proceed to Equipment Warm-up in the Warm-up Gym. The group will be in a holding area until the Equipment Warm-Up time starts. A sound system will be available.

Performance – After Equipment Warm-Up, students will be led to the Performance Gym. The group will be in a holding area until the official set-up and performance time starts.

*A HORIZONTAL Time Line will be used for all groups in the Performance Gym.*



## **POST PERFORMANCE**

After you exit the performance area, staff members should make sure that equipment is loaded up on equipment trucks. Floor folding is in a lot outside, take a right as you exit the gym down the hallway, then take a left and straight outside. Please fold floors quickly and exit the area to prevent a “traffic jam.”

## **RETREAT**

All performing members for every unit will line up in the Equipment Warm-up Gym after the last performance to prepare for a Full Blackout Retreat. Please refrain from using glowsticks as they can pop and damage the gym floor. Retreat should begin promptly at the conclusion of the contest. There will be no critique.

## **CONCESSIONS**

Concessions will be available throughout the contest right outside the Performance Gym. Outside food or drink will not be allowed inside the school. Payment will be taken with cash or through Cashapp.
