Turn **RIGHT** after the Baseball field


BUS & TRUCK DIRECTIONS:

All contest rules and regulations from the 2026 TECA Constitution and By-Laws and 2026 WGI Rule Books will be followed.

PARKING

Spectator parking is in the SHS Student Lot at the corner of Lamar St. and College St.

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN AT THE MAIN ENTRANCE OF SEGUIN HS FOR SECURITY OF PERFORMERS. SIGNS WILL BE POSTED AT THE STREET AND DOOR BEFORE ENTERING.

Equipment trucks (floors and props) will be unloaded at the main entrance of Seguin HS at 1315 E Cedar St. After unloading floors and props, equipment trucks should park in the lot in between the school and stadium.

Buses should unload at unit check-in. After drop off, park around the back on the corner of College and Lamar St in the Bus Loop or Across the Street at Cedar St. (See Map) Buses may also park along Lamar St next to the HS.

CHECK-IN

GUARD & PERCUSSION: Check-in will be at the volunteer table located just inside the glass doors Signs will point the way. DO NOT ENTER THE PERFORMING ARTS CENTER.

Equipment - Make sure equipment is appropriately padded and taped. T&P Judge will be checking and assessing penalties.

Directions and performance times will be posted throughout the campus.

PERFORMERS, CREW, & STAFF ADMISSION

Admission will be given to performers and up to 10 chaperone & crew members.

UNIT HOLDING AREA

Each unit will have a designated area in the Cafeteria, or one of two other hallway zones to store personal items. Individuals are responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Concessions will be available both in the cafeteria and at the SAC.

No outside food or drink is allowed in the high school. Support Show Host Schools.

Students and Staff may not spin, toss, or maneuver equipment inside the building at any time other than in designated areas. You may use anywhere outside for extra equipment warmup.

ONLY PERFORMERS & STAFF IN THE CAFETERIA. LIMIT TO 2 CHAPERONES PER UNIT.

PERFORMANCE (FOLLOW ARROWS)

***Ready* – When it is time for your group to be ready. There will be no guides. You will be responsible for reporting to official warm up times.**


***Body Warm-Up* – Students may stretch or do a run through of body mechanics. No equipment will be utilized during the body warm-up segment of the official warm-up time. A sound system will be available.**

***Equipment Warm-Up* – From Body Warm-Up, students will proceed to equipment warmup. The group will be in a holding area until the Equipment Warm-Up time starts. A sound system will be available.**

***Performance* - After Equipment Warm-Up, students will be led to the performance area. The group will be in a holding area until the official set-up and performance time starts.**

SEGUIN HS will not be providing guides for each unit.

ALL UNITS will be using a HORIZONTAL Center Line Flow for the Performance Area



DRUMLINES: *Same as 2025 all will push from EQ Trucks through Unit Check In Entrance. Continue down the hallway to the performance gym entrance. (see flow map on page 3)

POST PERFORMANCE

After you exit the performance area, staff members should make sure that equipment is put away. Floor folding is in the lot to your right as you exit the performance gym. Please fold floors quickly and exit the area to prevent a “traffic jam.”

The driveway between the gym and stadium will lead you back to the Equipment Trucks.

RETREAT


Captains will line up in the warm-up gym after the last performance. Retreat should begin promptly at the conclusion of the last performance.

GENERAL SPECTATORS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO GO “BACKSTAGE” FOR SAFETY.

RAIN PLAN

In the event of rain, directors will be given instructions via CompetitionSuite. Please make sure your information is up to date for your unit.

- Percussion will utilize dedicated warm up zones inside the high school
- Guard will continue as scheduled
- Winds will continue as scheduled
- **ALL: the decision to use floor or props will be at your discretion, but remember you can not leave water behind when you exit the performance floor.**

CONCESSIONS

Concessions will be available throughout the contest at the performance gym (SAC) and in the cafeteria. Outside food or drink will not be allowed inside the school.
